### School Cross Country Event Next Wednesday 16 May:

The School Cross Country is to be held next Wednesday, and parents are asked to please read the school procedure below:

#### a) Sharing Images of Students:

West Eyreton School follows guidelines to protect students' privacy and safety at school when we [publish student information](#). This includes sharing photos of our students. We encourage parents to also consider privacy issues when sharing photos and videos taken at school events.

We are happy for parents to take photos/videos of their children at sports day, cultural day, or other public school events. If copyright issues apply, such as at a school play, which forbid photos or videos to be taken, the school makes this known.

If parents want to share photos/videos on social media, they should consider the following:

- Show the images to your children and discuss them before posting them on social media. This will help your children understand that they should always think about what goes out to the public on the internet.
- If the images have pictures of other students, think about editing to remove them.
- Make sure that other students are not named in any online posts.

Parents should remember that posting photos of other people can amount to harassment and they should take care to ensure photos are fair to other people. This ensures everyone can enjoy school events without worrying what will end up on social media.

**b)** Please also note that the School Cross Country is a school day and children need to remain at school until 3.00 pm. We respectfully ask parents not to take their children home early; following their event, pupils need to remain at school until 3.00 pm with all other pupils.

### **Entertainment Book Fundraiser Distribution Process:**

This year a new approach is being trialled where each family will receive an Entertainment book; pupils will be bringing one book home to their family tomorrow, or early next week.

### **Emergency Procedures:**

The school has a text messaging system that is used to contact families in emergency or school closure situations.

The school's notification procedures are:

1. A text message system – in the event of an emergency or school closure, we will send a message via the school phone App to advise of the situation at school & updates on opening dates / times
2. A message will be placed on the main school phone advising parents of the situation at school
3. Where possible, school closure messages will be placed on the Breeze radio station.
4. The emergency telephone tree will be actioned, if no.s 1 – 3 above can't be activated.
5. Check with neighbours, friends if you think there is potential for the school to be closed but you haven't been contacted – emergency communication can be tricky e.g. weather, earthquake

For these procedures to operate effectively, it is vital that we have the correct cell phone numbers for all families please.

### **Emergency Telephone Tree List:**

The emergency telephone tree list for Term 2 is being emailed to families today. A paper copy will be attached to newsletters for those families who receive a "paper version". Since the list was sent home in Term 1 there has been changes with new families enrolling etc.

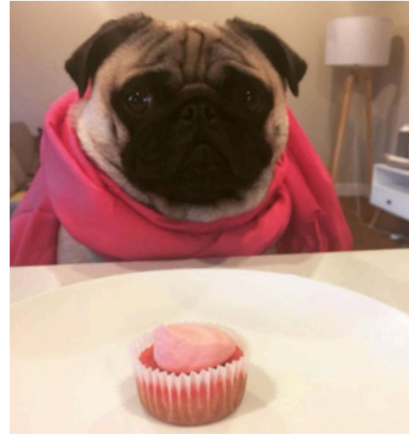



### **Measles Alert for Schools and Early Childhood Centres**

As the majority of children head into the term one school holidays, it is important to remind parents to be mindful of the risks of measles.

Over the past week, there have been five confirmed cases of measles reported in Queenstown, Wanaka, Canterbury and Nelson-Marlborough, and other cases are possible, including elsewhere in New Zealand.

Measles is a serious and highly infectious disease, and these new cases show how easily it can spread.

Families/whanau are encouraged to make sure they are fully immunised against measles and be aware of measles symptoms if they (or their children) are not fully immunised.

Immunisation is the best protection to stop you and your children getting measles. For the best protection, people need to have two MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) vaccinations. The MMR is available from your family practice and is free to eligible people.

With the school holidays coming up, parents should be mindful families and children could be exposed to measles, especially if they are travelling, attending events, holiday programmes, camps, or have friends and family travelling to visit them.

Anyone who is not immunised and gets exposed to a case of measles will need to stay home for at least 14 days to ensure the virus doesn't spread.

Anyone who suspects they may have measles should avoid contact with other people, especially those who aren't fully immunised, and should phone their GP or call Healthline on 0800 611 116 for advice.

It is important to call your GP first because measles is highly infectious, and people with measles can infect others in the waiting room.

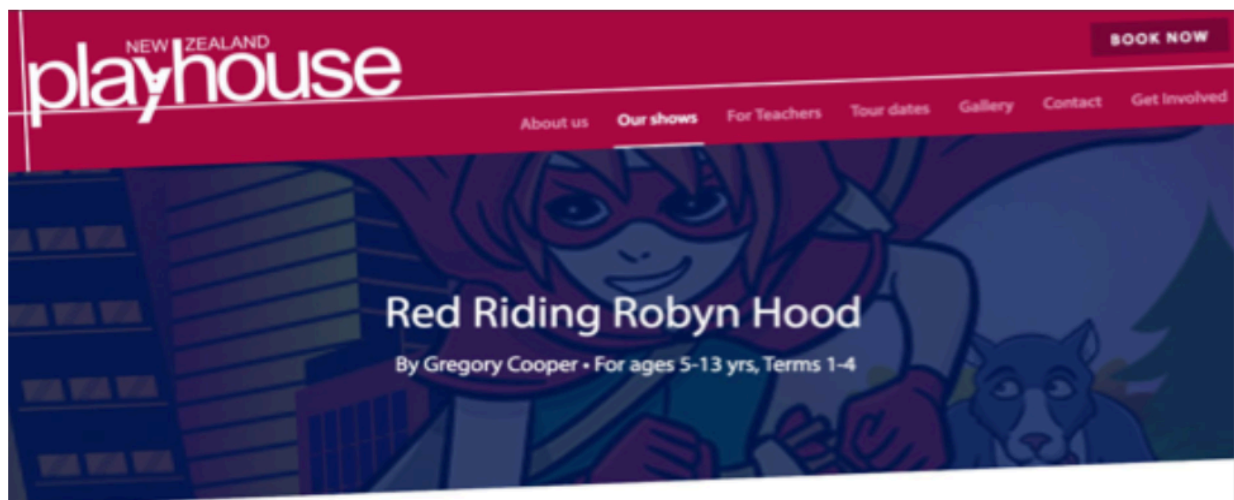
