School Open Afternoon:

Calves at Pet Day 29 October, term four:

Due to the risk of cross infection by **Mycoplasma bovis**, and the number of requirements to manage calves coming to school from different farms, a decision has been made not to include calves at Pet Day for this year only (future years will be considered afresh).

However, children are still able to rear a calf at home, and enter a Calf project at Pet Day as well as the Agricultural Project badge work. This project work will be judged at Pet Day; judges will still interview the children at Pet Day (not on the farm) about the condition of their calf, how they care for & lead their calf.
